What's the deal with the hydro?

RiverHeath will be powered by an on-site hydro-electric facility that dates to the 1850s—one of the oldest in the country. The hydro will be located in a 5000sf structure, just below the College Avenue bridge at the end of the Banta Court cul-de-sac.

Kaukauna Utilities has agreed to refurbish and operate the three turbines, each one capable of generating up to 350 kilowatts (kw). All together that's about one megawatt (MW) of clean power from the river! To put that power generation in perspective, the Hoover Dam generates over 2000 MW from its 17 turbines. Even one megawatt will be more than enough to power the homes,

shops, and office space for the project. The average home pulls about 5kw, and our energy efficient units should draw less than 3kw each, leaving us the capacity for more than 300 units. And we won't have to worry about blackouts—as long as our generator, the Fox River, keeps flowing.
