RiverHeath: What's in a Name?

The name "RiverHeath" is a combination of our western boundary, the Fox River, and a grassy park area, or "heath", in the center. We have over 1000 feet of frontage on the Fox and felt as if that deserved some attention.

What about Heath? There is a village in London, England, called Blackheath. It's about 5 miles southeast of the city center, close to Greenwich and the Thames River. Despite being in one of the most densely populated cities in the world, the

village has a vast area of public open grassland that they call the "Heath."

July 21 - 6th Annual Park-to-Park Paddle: Join hundreds of other paddlers on a journey through the waterways. The adventure starts Saturday 8:30am at the Shattuck Park launch site in Neenah, then moves east into Lake Winnebago, through Menasha in the Fox River and navigation canal, through the Menasha Lock, north through Little Lake Butte des Mort into the Fox River and ending at Lutz Park in Appleton.
