LED lights lead the way

Wisconsin architects Engberg Anderson are busy with the lighting design at RiverHeath. One of the primary goals is to deliver a system that creates warmth without consuming enormous amounts of energy. LED lights consume as much as 80% less energy than incandescent bulbs and last more than 100 times longer, so you can understand why they were a natural choice in our design, particularly in areas where you do not want to change bulbs every week. Take for example the brick archways of the inner harbor. Preserving and lighting this feature will create a soft, inviting area for residents and community members to gather during evenings overlooking lock #4 and the rest of the riverway.
